Dreams

Never lose sight of the fact that inspiration and the **permission to dream** is hugely important [4:13]

Dreams must be **specific** [4:56]

there for reason

Brick Walls [5:57] & [18:17]

won't stop those who want it badly enough

stop the 'other' people

Sometimes you can **learn more** from the dreams you don't accomplish than the dreams you do accomplish [8:30]

"Experience is what you get when you didn't get what you wanted" [11:21]

"It's cool to meet your boyhood idol. But it's even cooler when he comes to you to see what cool stuff you're doing in your lab" [14:56]

"It's kind of fun to do the impossible" [62:52]

Feedback

"When you're screwing up and no body is saying anything to you anymore, that's when they have given up" [10:02] So be thankful that they are 'on your case' because they care about you!

"Get a **FEEDBACK LOOP** and listen to it!" [73:08]

Definition

"HEAD FAKE" = something you learned indirectly from that which you initially intended to learn [11:39]

These are critical!

Keep you eye for them

They are everywhere

Negotiation

"Have something to bring to the table because that will make your more welcome" [ie, Give to Receive] [7:21]

Situational Example: Randy at first conference, at conclusion of his presentation, HUGELY famous person in the 'virtual reality' industry asked him a question.

NEGOTIATIONS [23:49]

Get common ground early

Avoid conflicts during a negotiation

go the decision maker quickly - ie, duck "gatekeepers"

Excellent example of:

(a) humility

(b) asking a question in a way and at a time that is impossible to say 'no' too

"It's very important to know when you're in a p***ing match, and it's very important to get out as quickly as possible"

"Let's back off a little. Do you think this is a good idea at all?"

"Is this your call [ie, to decide if it's a good idea anyway]?"

Randy said, "Did you say you were Tom Ferness?"

Tom said, "Yes"

Randy said, "I'd love to answer your question, but first, would you lunch with me tomorrow?"

"I'm going to be out in the area for a conference shortly, would you like to have lunch"

"80 hrs talking to VR experts around the world"

"If you had access to this one unbelievable project, what question would you ask?"

Easy to appear smart when you channel the thoughts of many intelligent people

Rapid Learning

Speak to experts in the area you want answers too. It's so much faster than trying to go it alone [21:57]

Communication

"Wait long enough and people will surprise and impress you" [23:14]

The **WAY** you say something is far more important than **WHAT** you say [26:02]

Look for metaphors in life to describe complex things to people [48:32]. It makes it a lot simpler to understand and to get your point across.

HEAD FAKE: "The best way to teach somebody something is to have them think they're learning something else" [52:50]

Everybody will show you their good side in time. Just keep waiting [74:24]

"One of my star faculty members is in here and I don't have much information so I want to learn more"

Comment by Randy's "Dutch Uncle", Andy van Dam: "Randy, it's such a shame that people perceive you as so arrogant because it's going to limit what you are going to be able to accomplish" [58:50]

eg, The ETC (Masters Degree in Entertainment Technology) is to "masters degrees" as Cirque Du Soleil is to "circus"

Qualities

Fundamentals

Fundamental, fundamentals, fundamentals ... you've got to get the fundamentals down because otherwise the fancy stuff isn't going to work [9:36]

Whenever you do something pioneering you can expect "a few arrows in the back" (ie, a whole things can and will go wrong) but keep persisting [44:30]

Try something new once in a while. Coach Graham made the team switch positions for just one play. All the small guys became receivers, etc. [10:35] This creates **freedom of thought**, gives you a **new perspective**, makes you **respect another person's point of view**, increases your level of **enthusiasm**.
